- Manage **financial assets**
- Own and develop **business processes**
- Manage **threats** and **resource allocation**
- Provide **analytical insights** into key concerns for the organization
- Manage **enterprise-wide policy**
- Conduct business **intelligence reporting** and **analysis**

## What are the Job Types?

### Business Analyst :

An internal business consultant who manages projects, analyzes data, and creates and delivers presentations to FBI senior executives.

### IT Specialist:

A critical resource who configures, analyzes, adapts, and develops new IT processes and systems.
